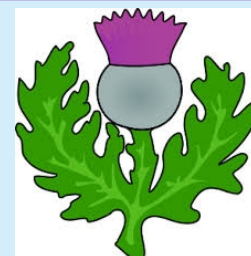
### **Traditional Burns Night**
