## Should we convert the BT phone box to a Defibrillator Cabinet?

The kiosk can usually be adopted for £1 and converted for use as a home for a Community Public Access Defibrillator (CPAD), storing the defibrillator in an accessible, well recognised, safe, weather protected location. This would cost about £1500 - £2000 including the defib.

We have already raised over £150 for a new CPAD from Carol singing. Originally the intention was to install it at the village hall, but maybe it would be better in the phone box.

The cost would be similar for either option.
